



West Northamptonshire Strategic Plan Public Notice

*Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004
The Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012*

In line with Regulation 18 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 and the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act (2004), Daventry District Council, Northampton Borough Council, South Northamptonshire Council and Northamptonshire County Council are working together on a West Northamptonshire Strategic Plan. The plan will set out the direction of economic and population growth for the area up to the year 2050.

The new plan will follow on from the West Northamptonshire Joint Core Strategy published five years ago, which needs updating to reflect revised national policies and changing local circumstances. These include plans for a new West Northamptonshire unitary authority and the area's location within the Oxford-Cambridge Arc which the government has identified as an area of significant economic potential.

The consultation period will run from **5 August until 11 October 2019**.
